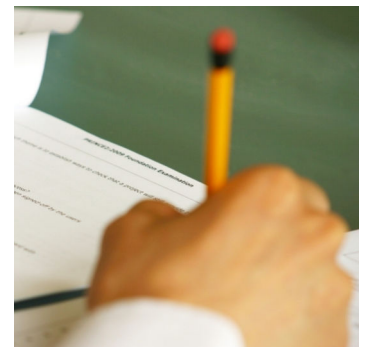

## Pre-requisites

You must have passed the PRINCE2 Practitioner exam 3-5 years ago in order to attend the course.

## Pre-course preparation

You will be provided with online pre-course preparation in order to familiarise yourself with PRINCE2 before attending the course. The online pre-course preparation consists of a concise introduction to PRINCE2, as well as a quiz, and should take approximately 4-5 hours to complete. The materials are commended by our delegates for their clear style. 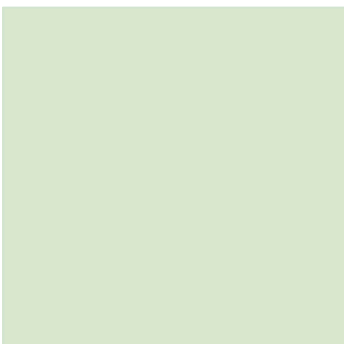

### PRINCE2 Practitioner Re-registration exam

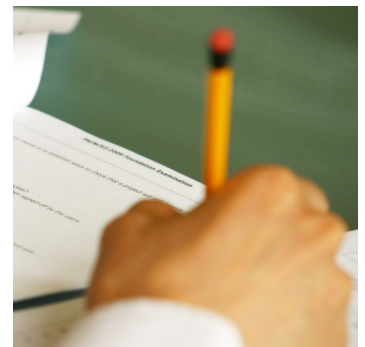
The course includes the 1-hour open-book, complex multiple-choice PRINCE2 Practitioner Re-registration examination on the Sunday afternoon. You must score 55% or more to pass. You are allowed to use your PRINCE2 manual during the exam; annotations and page markers are permitted in the manual.

You will be asked to perform approximately 2 hours of homework on Saturday evening.
