

Exam structure

On day 3 of the course, you will take the Foundation exam. This is a 1 hour closed book exam containing 75 questions and must score a minimum of 35 correct answers to pass. You'll be pleased to know that our current pass rate for MSP Foundation is 100%.

On day 5 you will sit the multiple choice MSP Practitioner exam. This is a 2.5 hour open book exam containing 80 questions and you must score a minimum of 40 correct answers to pass. Our current pass rate for MSP Practitioner is 90%.


Courses to suit modern life
