

Product Owner – represents the customer, communicates the priorities and vision to the team.

Scrum Master - acts as a facilitator between the Product Owner and team.

Development Team – self-organized, responsible for developing the product.

Once all the user stories are completed to the Product Owner's satisfaction, the product is ready to give to the customer.

O Product increment*

The increment is the output of all product backlog items completed during the sprint and previous sprints. It must be in a useable condition. The Product Owner decides whether to release it.

Sprint planning

The Product Owner presents the highest priority items from the Product Backlog to the Development Team. The Development Team decide what they can complete for the sprint and break user stories into tasks, estimating the effort and transferring them to a sprint backlog.

Working on the increment and tracking progress continues throughout the sprint.


